Class Descriptions

Preschool: For ages 5 and under. This class will be a time of imaginative and instructional play. All activities and toys will be will be appropriate for young children.

Kindergarten - 2nd Grade: Five in a Row

Five in a row is a fun curriculum to use with younger children and explore the world of imagination, history, math, geography, science, and so much more through simply reading a book. Each class we will read a simple picture book and do activities relating to the book. It is designed to be fun while yet, hopefully:-), educational. Every month will be a different book and probably different activities. We will read books in season as we approach them and just enjoy a time of fellowship together while we work.

Supplies Needed: Your children will need crayons or colored pencils, glue and a pencil. We may or may not use these every month but we will use them at times and I will have extra if your child does not have them. Some times little ones just think its a big deal to carry their own bag:-)

To begin, the children will develop their creativity through fun drawing projects. The class will cover basic drawing techniques, such as line, shape, and perspective. Each class throughout the year will feature different projects and techniques. Students will learn to communicate their ideas through their art and develop their observation and perspective skills.
